- St. Petersburg College's (SPC) Florida Regional Community Policing Institute (RCPI) offers two HT online, one-hour trainings: Awareness of Human Trafficking and Responding to Human Trafficking. <u>Community Awareness Focus Group</u> - Help distribute resource information such as bookmarks, pamphlets, etc.; attend one of St. Petersburg College, Regional Community Policing Institute's free, four-hour courses-"*The Many Faces of Human Trafficking*". (You will receive notification of upcoming trainings once you have inserted your email address on the homepage of www.CATFHT.Org); receive training to become a member of the Community Campaign's Speakers' Bureau and then make Community Awareness Presentations in your area. <u>Victim Services Focus Group</u> — Help provide appropriate short term and long term protective shelters and services including medical, psychological, and spiritual care critical for the protection and restoration of both adult and child sex trafficking victims. Victims require specialized care while being secured from their traffickers; pool of Victim Service resources must be established in order that victim needs will not "fall through the cracks"; Email Olga Barulli, World Relief Tampa Project Coordinator at <u>obarulli@wr.org</u> with offers of donations of goods and/or services for short term services. Contact Laura Hamilton at <u>laura@bridgingfreedom.org</u> to help establish a long term therapeutic safe home for domestic minor sex-trafficking victims.

<u>Fundraising/Awareness Events Focus Group</u>- Funds are necessary for both Community Awareness and Victim Services. Funds are also necessary for Law Enforcement and other Front Line workers' Training Scholarships. Silo funding must be sought to meet critical emergency victim needs.
